

Course Name: ASTM F770 Inspection and Maintenance

Description:

The class is intended to provide students an opportunity to understand how the former F893 Inspection Standard and F853 Maintenance Standard have been incorporated into F770 against the back drop of the harmonization efforts within the F24 committee. The information will provide an overview of how the harmonization effort affected these standards, the sub-task groups involved in making this a reality, and most importantly what it means to the end users.

Audience:

This program is designed for ride owners/operators, maintenance, inspectors and other amusement personnel who require continuing education and training for maintaining their certification to work in their respective positions per AHJ regulations and/ or company policies. This program is also ideal for individuals wishing to remain current on latest industry trends, standards and best practices applicable to their day to day job duties as it relates to their role.

Specific target audience includes:

Ride device, water slide, water attractions, trampoline and adventure course inspectors, maintenance personnel, owner/operators, management and manufacturers.

Prerequisites:
